Log Cabin Camp ACTIVITIES INSTRUCTIONS

SCAVENGER HUNT

An exciting activity for children to participate in, hunting for a variety of different items. This activity challenges children's logic while at the same time simply helping them to discover the campsite.

EQUIPMENT

Scavenger/score cards Pencils Plastic Bags

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Campers should work in groups of 2 or 3. Each group requires a score sheet and plastic/paper bag.
- 2. Groups are required to find the objects listed on the score sheet
- 3. Groups are allowed anywhere on campsite property as directed by activity leader
- 4. Leader is required to help campers work out their score
- 5. Campers are required to dispose of items and bags in bin

DURATION:- Total 40 minutes to an hour

LOCATION

Log Cabin Camp campsite. The group leader can set the boundaries.

AGE SUITABILITY

The activity is suitable for all ages, but is best suited to a younger age group. (ages 5 -12 years).

RATIO.

1:10 It is recommended that there is one Instructor/Leader per ten participants, This activity can take several participants, as long as it is well supervised, e.g. 2:30, 3:30 etc.

INSTRUCTOR EXPERIENCE.

No experience is necessary but previous experience instructing and supervising small groups in recreation activities would be an advantage.

ASSISTING LEADERS EXPERIENCE.

No previous experience is required for an assistant. An assisting leader is not essential for this activity, but if one is available can be very useful.

PARTICIPANTS EXPERIENCE.

No previous experience in the activity is required.

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INSTRUCTOR RESPONSIBILITY

The Instructor is responsible for camper supervision and behaviour at all times, this includes: the supervision and behaviour of campers at the activity and to and from the activity. The Instructor is also responsible for: assessing first aid requirements and identifying campers with asthma or other ailments; adhering to Log Cabin Camps rules for the conduct of the Scavenger Hunt; and ensuring that all the equipment is returned to the program room at the end of the activity.

The Instructor/Leader must inform the Assisting Leader (if one is available) of their role in the supervision of the activity.

*No sticking head in plastic bags

PARTICIPANTS RESPONSIBILITY

Participants are responsible for adhering to the instructions of the instructor.

PARTICIPANTS CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES

Solid footwear, sunscreen, sun hat.

FIRST AID REQUIREMENTS

The location of the activity is on the campsite, so if any injury should occur the designated camp first aider should be consulted.

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
