Log Cabin Camp ACTIVITIES INSTRUCTIONS

Labyrinth Description

The group must find their way across the Labyrinth via the secret pathway drawn below. If a square chosen is wrong the participant must go back to the back of the line and the next person will begin following the path and so on until all participants have crossed the Labyrinth via the secret path.



INSTRUCTIONS

Log Cabin Camp will provide wood for the campfire in the designated area. The Activity Leader is required to set the fire (suggested during daylight hours) prior to the activity and is then required to light the fire when the group is ready to start the activity. Please ask camp manager ahead of time if you require help to set the fire.

Don't forget to douse your fire at the conclusion if instructed.

LOCATION

Beside the BBQ area

AGE SUITABILITY

The activity is suitable for participants 10+.

<u>RATIO</u>

1:15 It is recommended that there is one Instructor/Leader per 15 participants.

INSTRUCTOR EXPERIENCE

Instructors with previous experience supervising small groups in recreation activities would be an advantage.

ASSISTING LEADERS EXPERIENCE

No previous experience is required for an Assistant.

PARTICIPANT EXPERIENCE

No previous experience in the activity is required.

INSTRUCTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY

The Instructor is responsible for camper supervision and behaviour at all times. Overall the Instructor is responsible for ensuring First Aid needs are met.

- ➢ Keep control of group
- > Identifying participants with medical conditions which may arise during the activities.
- > Ensuring the safety of all participants during the activity.

PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITY

Participants are responsible for adhering to the instructions of the Instructor.

PARTICIPANT'S CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES

Sunhat, sunscreen and solid footwear during summer and warm clothes during winter.

FIRST AID REQUIREMENTS

The location of the activity is on the campsite, so if any injury should occur, the designated camp First Aider should be consulted.
