COVID-19 Policy & Procedures

General information for schools (COVIDSafe Plan available on our website)

Log Cabin Camp is following the same guidelines issued for Victorian schools with regards to vaccination status of employees. All Log Cabin Camp staff have completed the Victorian Government's *Operating a hospitality business in a COVID-19 environment* training and all our staff are familiar with the Hospitality Industry Guidelines for coronavirus (COVID-19)

Overview

- Log Cabin Camp requires all schools/groups to screen campers, school staff & helpers before coming on camp. Any person who shows any symptoms of coronavirus (fever, breathing difficulties, sore throat, fatigue, or tiredness) or has been given a 'stay at home' directive by the DHHS, must NOT come on camp.
- If a child or camper becomes sick or develops symptoms while on camp, they will be isolated and kept away from other campers until they can be picked up.
- Schools will need all staff and volunteers over 18 to complete contact tracing information sheet including first name and phone number and to sign in with our QR code.
- Log Cabin Camp has implemented an increased and more frequent cleaning & disinfecting schedule, focusing on high use and common touch areas, in addition to regular and thorough cleaning between groups.
- In accordance with current hospitality guidelines, Log Cabin Camp has placed hygiene signage around the campsite, encouraging good hygiene practises for all campers.
- Log Cabin Camp staff will encourage and promote good hygiene practices & seek to maintain healthy social distancing, as long as it doesn't interfere with or hinder campers' safety.
- As usual, all campers will wash their hands before every meal. Log Cabin Camp will provide hand sanitiser in compliance with good hygiene practices.

Activities

There is still a need for our activity staff to be in close contact with campers during activities in order to keep them safe during the activity, however Log Cabin Camp staff will be minimising contact where possible, and encouraging good hygiene for all participants.

- Log Cabin Camp staff will provide hand sanitiser as required.
- Activity equipment will be cleaned and disinfected between each school group.

Mealtimes

- During mealtimes unnecessary contact will be limited where possible.
- Social distancing at teachers/adults' tables will be made possible with extra tables provided.
- Duty groups will have duties dependent on restrictions. Each individual camper will be responsible for clearing their own plate, cup and cutlery. All dishwashing is carried out by Log Cabin Camp kitchen staff.
